Meeting called to order by Carl 6:40pm

Minutes on Line Minutes from April were reviewed. **MOTION:** By Richard Stark to approve January minutes. Philip Gentry seconded. Vote to approve was unanimous.

BAYSA Minutes: Reviewed. BAYSA held their elections. Thomas Morrow was elected President, Rich Newell was elected Treasurer, and Shirley McGraw was elected Registrar/Secretary. The Playoff director is currently an open position. They will also need to elect a new VP/D&P to replace Thomas Morrow who was elected to President.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. **President Report:** GCYS is still looking for a President. Carl will continue as the interim President until a replacement can be nominated. The board approved via email to have a billboard placed along Highway 45 for Registration. This will be up around May 15 and run through August. Volunteer form discussed, but tabled to next month for further discussion.
2. **Treasurer Report:** Financials reviewed. Taxes have been completed and filed. BAYSA also received a copy. BAYSA still has not set their fees for Fall.
3. **Registrar Report:** Walk up Registration begins April 30 @ RJ Wollam in Santa Fe. May 7 at Mall of the Mainland, May 14 in Dickinson and May 21 in Galveston and Texas City.
4. **D&P Report:** No Report.
5. **Referee Report:** GCYS will be hosting a clinic. Michael Hughes will coordinate scheduling. GCYS will pay for the class for new referees providing that they agree to referee a certain number of games for GCYS.
6. **Scorekeeper Report:** Absent. No Report.
7. **Uniform Report:** We will use the same uniforms as last year. We will use DTI for the U9 and up uniforms and stay with Challenger for the U6 and U8 uniforms. Orders will be placed next week.
8. **Coaching and Development:** Absent. Tryouts will be: U11 May 2-5, U12 and up will be June 1 thru 8th. More specific information to come. All times will be 6:00pm – 7:30pm and all will be at Osborne fields in Texas City. COM will host our Coaches classes for no charge this year. July 8-10 will be the “E” class, time TBD, July 9 U/6-U/8 Module, and August 8 U10/U12 Module. Times TBD. More information will be on the website.
9. **Scheduler Report:** Absent. Dave Berg has resigned as the GCYS Scheduler. This is now an open position and we will actively look to fill this position.
10. **Fields:** Always need volunteers to help with all of our fields.
 - a. **Galveston:** The city has lights. Jay and Lee are fighting with the city for the Rights and Usage agreement on the lights.
 - b. **Texas City:** Richard Stark will resume communication with the city. TC will give one mower to SF. Will post information on a Field Day for Texas City soon. We will be losing the fields behind Fatima, but hopefully gaining access to the field by the old St. Johns Church. Osborne Connex was broken into. Not sure what was stolen. Carlos Garza complex will cost approximately \$35/hour to use their fields.

- c. Dickinson: Per Charles Hughes if we provide him with our plans for Lobit Park, they should be able to get them approved. Possible 8v8, 4 – 4v4 , 6 -3v3 fields.
- d. Santa Fe: SFISD will no longer be mowing the 22 acres around RJ Wollam. GCYS will have a moving schedule. Glen is working on a permit to be able to complete the electrical work for the building.

Old Business
