Minutes on Line Minutes from May were reviewed. **MOTION:** By Pam Mager to approve April minutes. Ed Moninghoff seconded. Vote to approve was unanimous.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. **President Report:** GCYS is still looking for a President. SHAL League. BAYSA is having a Presidents meeting to discuss this July9, 2011. Possibly look at using Cinemark movies as a marketing tool next season.

2. **Treasurer Report:** Financials reviewed. Registration looks up from last year, but still too early to say. BAYSA will have club fees directly withdrawn. No checks will need to be mailed.

 - a. **Galveston:** No changes.
 - b. **Texas City:** We will use St. John's Methodist Church for all 3v3, 4v4, and 6v6 games. 8v8 games will be moved to Osborne. 2 mowers were transferred to SF. Lack of rain is making the fields very dry and cracking.
 - c. **Dickinson:** Lobit has 6 3v3 fields, 3 4v4. Still trying to talk to DISD about having practice at the DHS practice fields. Philips will look into our usage agreement with DISD.
 - d. **Santa Fe:** All goals are back up after renovations from the Ag barn being built. Our new building cannot have running water until all the electrical is done. Still needs a bid to be completed. Hopefully can be done for less than \$4500.00 per Glen.

New Business

Tournament: GCYS will not have a free tournament for all registered teams this year. We will offer all GCYS team that register to receive ½ price of the regular registration for the tournament. Updated information will be posted on the website.

Open Parent/Coach Discussion: Richard Stark would like for GCYS to hold its monthly meeting in each town. He would like to Board and Committee members to travel to different towns each month so that parents in each city would be able to attend a meeting at least 3 times a year instead of having the meeting in a central location each month.
