Meeting called to order by Jay @ 6:40pm

Minutes on Line Minutes were reviewed. **Motion** by Glenn Elliott and seconded by Mandy Jackson for approval. Vote was unanimous.

BAYSA Minutes: Reviewed. BAYSA requests that Club Officers need to be turned in to Shirley. Schedulers need to communicate better. Spring teams are only allowed 2 guest players. March 15 is the deadline for Coach/Volunteer of the Year forms to be turned in to Shirley. BAYSA medical forms are on their website for player injuries.

### COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. **President Report:** Fall Season Discussed. Registration flier discussed. School Districts will need to be contacted regarding fliers. Mandy will contact Dickinson, Nikki – Clear Creek, Pam – Santa Fe, Dave – Galveston, and Melinda will contact Texas City. Need to mail fliers to all previous registered players. Constitution was discussed and will be

revisited during the April Meeting. Offer was made by the Houston Dynamo for GCYS to be Student of the Game for their April 10 game. **Motion** was made by Max Doner and seconded by Nikki Verberne to vote on this opportunity. Motion was denied. Vote was unanimous. Volunteer forms are being reviewed by Carl Huddleston. Each Board member is asked to review their description and make changes as needed and report back to Carl.

2. **Treasurer Report:** Budget discussed. We will have to wait and see how much BAYSA increases their fees.
3. **Registrar Report:** Pam Mager has resigned at Registrar for GCYS. Jay has appointed Nikki Verberne the replacement Registrar. Jay then appointed Pam Mager to Secretary for GCYS to replace Nikki.
4. **D&P Report:** No Report.
5. **Referee Report:** No report. .
6. **Scorekeeper Report:** Game reports for Spring Teams still need to be turned in on time.
7. **Uniform Report:** Mandy to do a Ghost order for the U-8 and below with the hopes of being able to give those players their uniforms at Registration. She will order 40 XS, 250 S, 180 YM, and 30 YL.
8. **Coaching and Development:** Jaime Palco is looking at hosting the clinics at College of the Mainland instead of Texas City High School due to the cost. COM is over \$400 cheaper. Classes to be scheduled for July 16-18 for E license. July 24 for U-12 and below. Max will get Jaime the Insurance Certificate so that he can turn that in to COM.

10. **Fields:** BAYSA suggested that we take down all nets until next season.
  - a. **Galveston:** Needs lights. Lee Kinard is working with the City to get lights on both sides of the poles. Leaks in sprinklers are being repaired by the City. City will seed and treat the fields. Connex from Bay Street needs to be moved to Galveston.
  - b. **Texas City:** The fields have no grass. Ed Moninghoff will fertilize the fields. Need to move a Port-a-can to the Fatima fields.
  - c. **Dickinson:** Carl is going to look into the needs of the DK fields. Work will be done on these fields this summer.
  - d. **Santa Fe:** SFIDS has begun construction of the new road and the land preparation for their Ag Building. Glenn will fertilize the fields. 30x30 building is ordered for SF. Slab will need to be done for the new building.

### **GCYS Uniform Colors:**
