BAYSA Minutes: Reviewed. BAYSA President Bob Maraia has resigned due to health reasons.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

1. **President Report:** Spring season discussed. BAYSA reviewed. GCYS will have 3 soccer camps this summer. GCYS will change the way that we conduct our monthly meetings We will have an "open" forum the first 30 minutes for coaches/parents to come it and discuss issues without having to wait thru the entire meeting.

2. Treasurer Report: Fall Registration fees will include the cost of coach's bags, all teams' entry into the tournament. All Teams who has a representative at 4 of the 6 meeting during the fall season will get a \$50.00 refund for a Team Party. All storage facilities paid thru April.
3. Registrar Report: Absent from meeting. Pam will not be Lead Registrar for the Fall Season. She will assist in all computer work. Nikki Verberne will take this responsibility. U-II and up will be handled by Pam and Nikki. U-10 and below will be handled by the coordinators for each city. Nikki will look into the cost of a Club Cell phone for Registration concerns.
4. D&P Report: Done for Fall Season. No Report.
5. Referee Report: No report.
6. Scorekeeper Report: No report.
7. Uniform Report: No Report. See new business. Had presentation from Challenger.
8. Coaching and Development: Jaime Palco will be getting his National Youth License. Dave *motioned* *thai* GCYS pays the \$650.00 fee for this. This was seconded by Nikki Verberne. The vote was unanimous. Clinic dates and tryout dates will be on the website.
9. Scheduler Report: Workshop on August 12, 2010.
10. Fields: BAYSA suggested that we take down all nets until next season.
 - a. Galveston: No change. Fields have been seeded.
 - b. Texas City: Light poles are up at the new Carlos Garza Park. No practice there, just games. There will a concession stand at this park and should be ready for Fall games. Bay Street storage will go to Galveston.
 - c. Dickinson: Charles Hughes was given a schedule for Lobit Park. Will also ask him what changes/improvements can be made at Lobit Park.
 - d. Santa Fe: SFISD has approved us replacing our building west of our little parking lot. The gravel road will be moved and one 11v11 field and the 3 8v8 fields will have to shift west to accommodate the new road and construction. No games will be played here in the Spring.

Old Business

Spring Season: This is a Team Season where complete teams will be able to play for a Team fee only. Teams must be loaded into Affinity by February 12, 2010. GCYS has 9 teams playing Spring thru BAYSA.

New Business

Challenger Uniform Presentation: Andrew Ford with Challenger came in with a presentation of uniforms. They will charge an additional \$2.50 for lettering and logo. They will shrink wrap each team individually. There is a one month turn around between ordering and receiving. As long as there is communication they can hopefully even have our order within 2 weeks. For late registrants as long as orders are in by noon Monday, we should be able to receive additional uniforms by noon Friday at an increased cost. They can have separate uniforms for competitive teams and they can give us samples for registration. We can also order equipment from them. Cost for recreational uniforms is approximately \$13.75/player. Competitive uniforms \$18.25 - \$19.25/uniform. This is not for name brand. Can order goalie shirts for a 15% discount. On our Ghost order, if they do not have lettering/numbering, they could be willing to take back extras. Andrew will check on this.

Dynamo Presentation: Travis Watkins and Casey Ellison represented the Dynamo to ask GCYS to join the Student of the Game program again this year. Silver level now has 400 tickets and 6-10 mini games. Packages available for tickets to the All Star Game for \$30- \$65/person before the general public have a chance to purchase tickets. Opportunity same as last year, also have new referees be able to have a discussion with the referees from the game after a game.
